### How can the Group help me?

The Scarborough Group runs fixed 10 week courses for new members (Associates) wanting to improve their driving skills. Associate members will be assigned an individual Observer (someone who has already passed the Advanced test) by the Group. This Observer will pass on knowledge and advice to the new Associate, which will help towards passing the IAM test. Observers and Associates meet on mutually convenient days and times over the 10 week period, all accompanied runs are in the Associate's own vehicle. The completed course is followed by two check tests administered by the Group before finally taking the IAM test. Guidance is available for both cars and motorcycles. Note: An Observer riding his/her own machine *follows* Associate motorcyclists.
